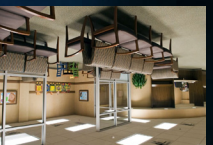

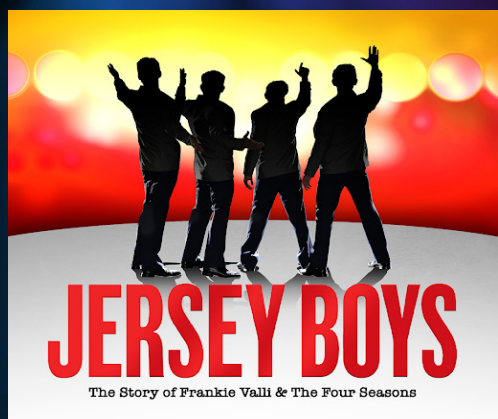

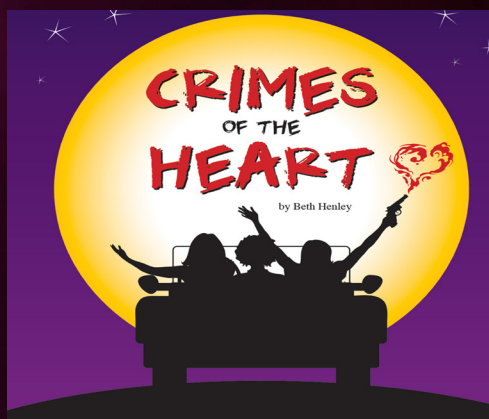

In a fun true story, they manage to persuade four friends to pose nude for a fundraiser calendar.
