### Musical Theatre Workshop

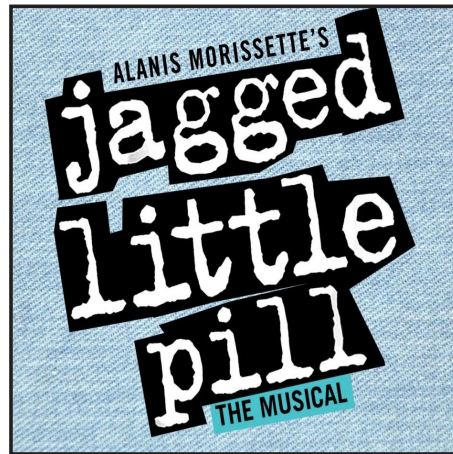

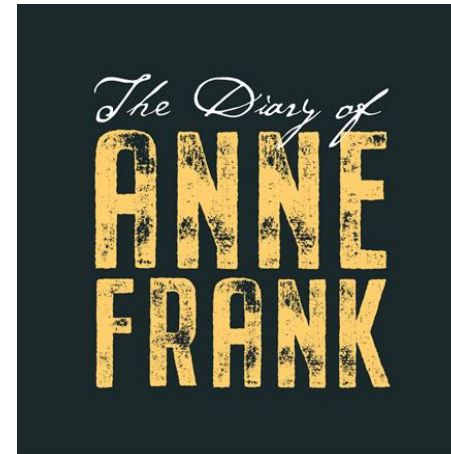

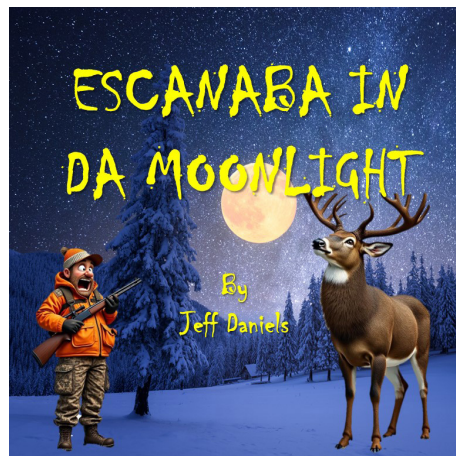
